BEFORE YOU BEGIN THE SIGN-UP PROCESS

SIGN THEM UP

To ensure a smooth sign-up process, remember to do the following three things:

1. TALK TO YOUR DEMONSTRATOR ABOUT THE PROCESS.

When you join Stampin' Up!, your demonstrator is your best resource. Before you begin, ask them to go over the sign-up process with you and ask any questions you may have. They will explain terms that may be new to you, help you decide what products to include in your demonstrator Starter Kit, and offer advice about the process.

2. HAVE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION READY.

Before you begin the sign-up process, gather your personal information so you have it ready.

You will need to enter your

- Name
- Email address
- Phone number
- Postal address (and shipping address, if different)
- Method of payment

Important note: You must pay for your own Starter Kit. It is against Stampin' Up! policy for your team leader to pay for your kit, even if you plan to reimburse them.

Depending on the country where you live, you may also need to enter your driver's license, or some other method of personal identification. For information regarding specific documents you will need for your country, please contact Demonstrator Support at 1800-SUSTMP (AU)/ 0800 202 722 (NZ) or au@stampinup.com/dsnz@stampinup.com.

You will be given the option to enter the name of a 'Supporting Demonstrator.' This is someone you authorise to act in your behalf, enabling them to place orders for you and speak to Demonstrator Support on your behalf. A Supporting Demonstrator must be the demonstrator's legal spouse as defined under the Domestic Relationship Laws of Australia or Property (Relationship) Act 1976 of New Zealand and must agree to the Terms & Conditions of our Independent Demonstrator Agreement, just as you have done.

3. HAVE YOUR LIST OF STARTER KIT CONTENTS READY.

Once you've entered your information, you will be able to shop and select the items you would like to include in your personal Starter Kit! There are many products to choose from, so we recommend spending a little time to decide on your selections in advance.

Select your kit contents based on the products you need. Decide whether you'll use them to grow your personal inventory or use them to hold your first class. You can also ask your demonstrator to provide advice on what to include in your kit.

Once you click 'Start Shopping,' you will have the option to select a recommended Starter Kit—or create one of your own. The Starter Kit has a set value limit, and you will be able to keep track of your kit total as you are assembling it. You will not be allowed to go over the set kit value, so select your items carefully to get as close as possible to the allowed value.

And remember, once you sign up, you will receive a 20% discount on catalogue products. (Hurray!)

Each kit contains a business supplies pack with items you will need if you choose to start your business.
